## Tasting Notes:



A blend of two barrels from two Beamsville Bench vineyards, Aberdeen and S. Kocsis. The 2007 Iconoclast Chardonnay represents the best of the 2007 harvest from these vineyards. The structure is the most notable, framing the richness of the 2007 and supporting the weight of the palate. Long in the finish, the iconoclast is still very youthful even though we have bottle aged it for a year before release. Recommend you consider cellaring this wine for five more years.
