Tasting Notes

- ▶ This 2009 chardonnay from our vineyards in Prince Edward County strikes a neat balance between fresh and ripe, crisp and round. Ripe apple and sweet citrus notes combine with a touch of toasted bread and a dollop of butter to create a pleasant, expressive nose. Flavorful, it opens up quickly on a juicy, citrusy note, going on to a clean and refreshing finish. Barrel fermentation and barrel aging in mostly old wood provide minimal oak character, but rather the roundness and extra complexity of a harmonious and gradual maturing process. Though it could benefit from an extra few years of cellaring, it's the most accessible of our 2009 barrel-fermented chardonnays from Prince Edward County.
